

NONCOACHING STAFF MEMBERS WITH **SPORT-SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES**

GENERAL RULES

Staff members must count against coaching limits in their sport if they participate in any of the following activities:

- Provide technical or tactical instruction to a student-athlete at any time. Make or assist in making tactical decisions during on-court or on-field practice or competition. Engage in any off-campus recruiting activities.

Noncoaching staff members with sport-specific responsibilities (e.g., director of operations, administra-tive assistant, quality control) may not participate in on-court or on-field activities.
